Your Questions Answered

1. Who is DMEscripts?

DMEscripts is an industry-led, e-prescribing platform focused on streamlining the ordering of Durable Medical Equipment (DME) to improve the patient and referral experience, reduce processing time, and allow DME suppliers to recognize substantial savings on administrative costs.

DMEscripts' e-prescribe platform allows more than 95% of electronic orders to be accepted and completed the first time received and empowers network providers to:

- Remove the rework of the current fax-based ordering process.
- Track orders from submission to delivery.
- Integrate with both electronic health records and billing systems.
- Securely message between prescriber and supplier.

2. What discount is available for this service under Integra's agreement?

All Integra Partners Providers will qualify for a 10% cost discount for access to DMEscripts' e-prescribe platform.

3. How does DMEscripts ensure that orders flowing through the platform are clean?

DMEscripts uses intelligent logic to pre-qualify each medical equipment order and then lets users know exactly what needs to be provided in their supporting documentation. Over 95% of electronic orders on DMEscripts are accepted and completed the first time received. This means DME suppliers can significantly reduce rework by receiving complete, accurate, billable and refillable prescriptions upfront.

4. Does DMEscripts have connectivity with any Practice Management Systems?

DMEscripts is currently integrated with Brightree, allowing Brightree users to find even more efficiencies through the DMEscripts platform. 5. How do I sign-up for the Integra-DMEscripts GPO offering?

To source services from any of Integra's vendor partners, you first have to fill out, sign, and submit an [Integra GPO Participation Form](#) via DocuSign. This form can be found by logging into *Que*, selecting the help icon (?) at the top right, and navigating to the Integra Partners Forms and Resources page. You only need to fill out this form once so if you have already done so you may skip this step.
